RULES

WELSH MEDAL CLASSES

The Welsh Medal Classes (i.e., the Breed classes for Sections A, B, C, D & Part-Bred In-Hand) are run under the WPCS rules governing medal awards. (A copy of these rules can be seen on the WPCS website or with the secretary on the day of the show).

EWPCA RULES FOR SHOW

1. The organisers, nor any of the Show's officers, servants or assistants shall not in any way be responsible or accountable to exhibitors or assistants or other members of the public, to any animal or property, to any vehicle brought onto the showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show, or whilst entering or leaving the same.
2. Any animal not under control or in any way constituting a danger shall be removed from the show ring or the showground at the request of the judge, steward or chairman and will be disqualified.
3. Any accident must be reported to the show secretary immediately.
4. The organisers reserve the right to amend the judges' panel if necessary and to amalgamate or cancel classes if there are insufficient entries.
5. All Welsh entries (except for those in the Driving classes) must be entered in the Welsh Stud Book or Appendices of the Stud Book or Welsh Part-Bred register. FS1 & FS2 are eligible. FS is not eligible.
6. All first prize winners must compete for their respective Championships.
7. No manes or tails to be plaited except in the Driving classes, Palomino & Part-Bred classes which is optional.
8. Exhibitors are not permitted to enter any animal in any class which is to be judged by a person who has had or has any financial interest in the animal.
9. THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.
10. Other than the initial starting time in each ring (09.00), all times are approximate.
11. No entry fee will be returned under any circumstances.
12. Stallions/Colts may not be led by any juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
13. All dogs are to be kept on leads.
14. All foals must be 3 weeks of age or over on the day of the show.
15. No smoking in any buildings on the showground.
16. Entrants to be responsible for the correctness of their entries regarding names and registration numbers and for their eligibility.
17. **Entries can be taken on the day for all classes except Welsh A, B, C, D & Part-Bred In-Hand Medal classes.**
18. Rosettes will be awarded to 6th place at the judge's discretion.
19. **Only EWPCA members can take trophies upon receipt of a signature.**
20. **All trophies taken must be returned in appropriate condition to the show secretary one month prior to 2024 Summer Show.**
21. Any member or exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing to the secretary with a deposit of £15 which will be returned if the objection is sustained. All objections shall be delivered within one hour of the incident.
22. Equine Influenza: All exhibits must have been vaccinated within the last 12 months but not within the last 7 days prior to the show. Passports may be randomly checked
23. No refunds will be given if classes are missed

In ridden classes a special rosette will be presented to the highest placed Welsh Section A, B, C or D pony/cob which will qualify for the WELSH Ridden Championship.

43. M&M Open Lead Rein

Registered Pure-Bred Mare or Gelding not exceeding 122cm, 4 years old and over. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. No child under the age of 3 years may compete. The leader must be 16 years old or over and may only lead one pony in a class. Canter is not allowed. The rein MUST go directly from the bit to the rider's hand, with no extra aid or attachments to/from the saddle. The reins must be a normal length and not knotted or stitched together at a shorter length. Handles on saddles are permitted but the reins MUST NOT be attached to the handle or the saddle. Riders will not be asked to dismount, and the ponies will not be stripped.

This class is a qualifier for **The National Welsh Championship Show 2024 – National Welsh Mini LR Championship** sponsored by The Brynseion Stud. All 1st & 2nd placed Section A or B ponies (not already qualified) qualify to enter.

44. M&M Open First Ridden

Registered Pure-Bred Mare or Gelding not exceeding 128cm, 4 years old and over. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. May be shown in any suitable bridle, except bit-less bridles and running gags. Ponies may be stripped. No cantering is allowed except for individual performances. Ponies should leave the ring at the walk or trot.

TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS".

Traditional Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the Traditional Finals at 'TOYS'.

Part Bred classes are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". The exhibit must have one parent that is a traditional gypsy cob.

Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook.

Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature.

Non-members MUST receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

Championships

Quest for a Star Championship Inc Youngstock Quest for a Star Traditional Gypsy Cobs

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes above may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship as per below rule.

ONLY current TGCA members and horse/pony that is already TGCA registered can exhibit in this championship, if the exhibit already has their Quest for a Star Qualification in particular section, they should be asked to stand aside to allow members that have not yet qualified.

Membership card and Member's qualification card (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

The Greatest Gelding Award - Traditional Gypsy Cobs

The award is aimed to encourage the showing of geldings, therefore creating a market for often unwanted colt foals and enabling the creation of a network of potential performance prospects to represent the best Traditional Gypsy Cob breed in the World at the highest level.

Go for Glory Championship - Part Bred Gypsy Cobs

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA part-bred classes may go forward to the Go for Glory Championship. The handler/rider and exhibits (apart from stallions) do not have to be TGCA members/registered on the date of the show. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Crowning Glory Championships at TOYS.

The Greatest Gelding Award – Part Bred Gypsy Cobs

The award is aimed to encourage the showing of geldings, therefore creating a market for often unwanted colt foals and enabling the creation of a network of potential performance prospects to represent the best Traditional Gypsy Cob breed in the World at the highest level.

59. Show Wagons – Section A

Open to registered Welsh Section A driven to a show wagon
Special Rosette to the winner

60. Show Wagons – Section C

Open to registered Welsh Section C driven to a show wagon
Special Rosette to the winner

61. Show Wagons – Section D

Open to registered Welsh Section D driven to a show wagon
Special Rosette to the winner

Notes for Driving Classes

1. No driver under the age of 16 years may drive a Stallion either in the ring or on the showground
2. All competitors must have 3rd party public liability insurance, and this may be inspected at any time by the show organisers
3. Horses and ponies entered any class must be 4 years old or over
4. All young drivers (junior whips) under the age of 18 years must be accompanied in the turnout by an adult groom (over the age of 18 years), who themselves is a competent carriage driver. This always applies not just to the show ring but on the showground. Show organisers reserve the right to ask for proof of age of the groom
5. Young drivers under the age of 14 must wear a hard hat
